### get cold feet

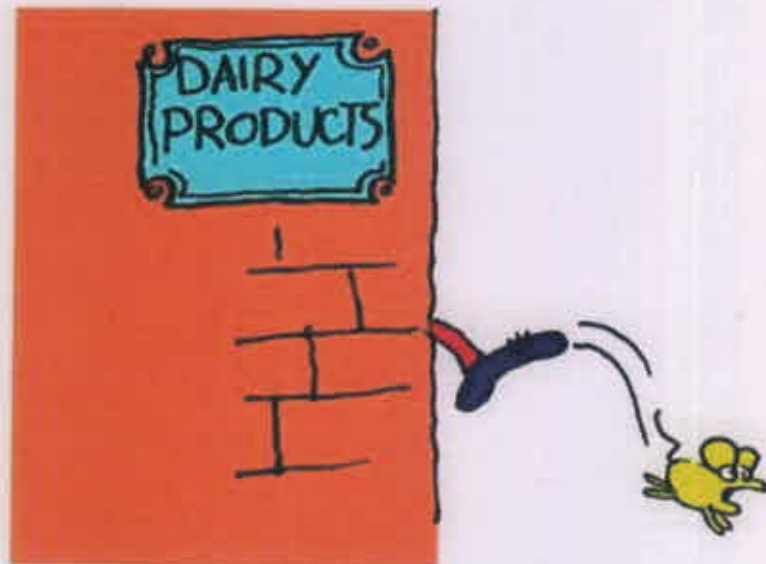

### get something out of one's system

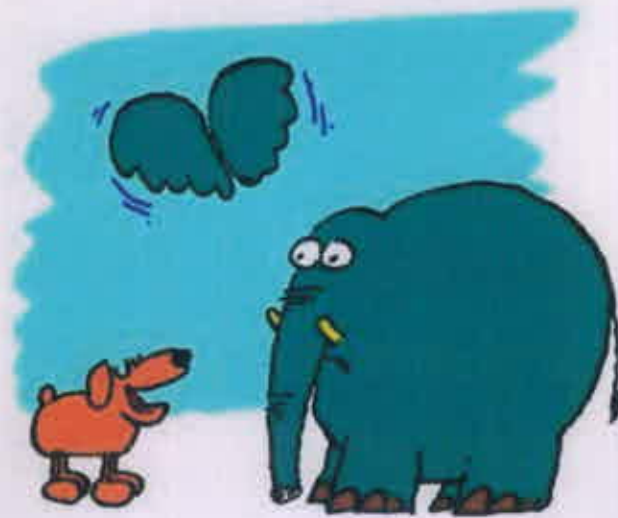

## get the ball rolling

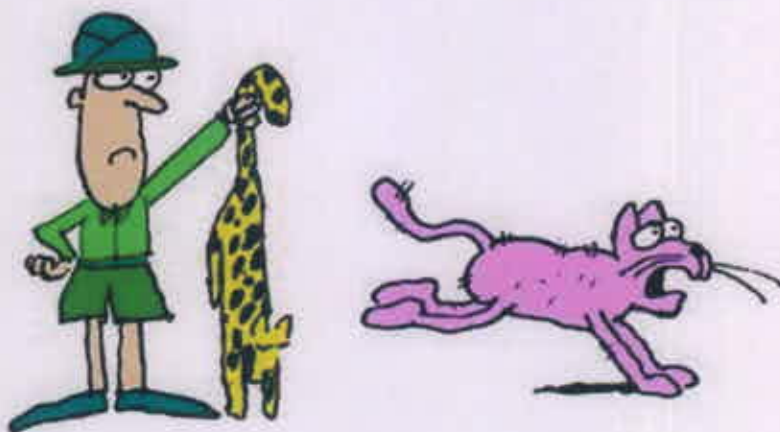

## lead a dog's life

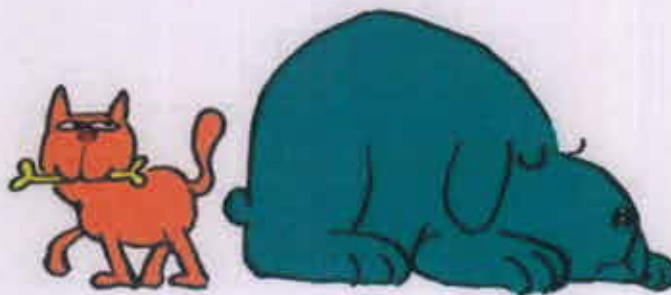

## go to the dogs

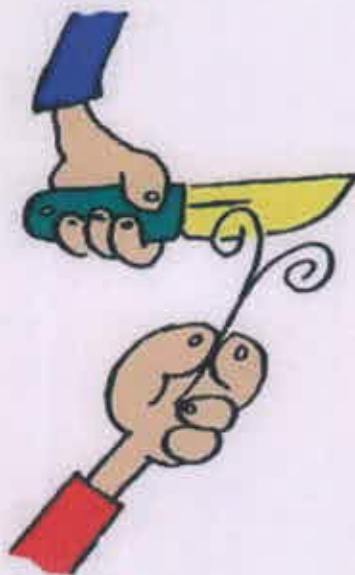

## piece of cake

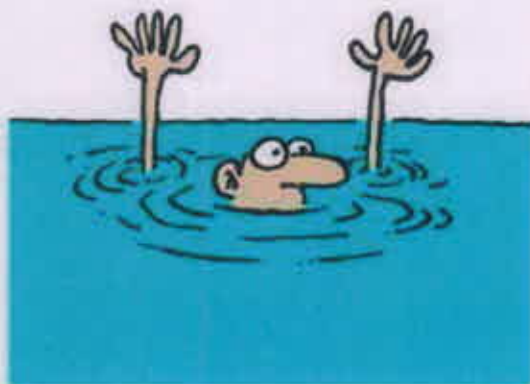

## pull someone's leg

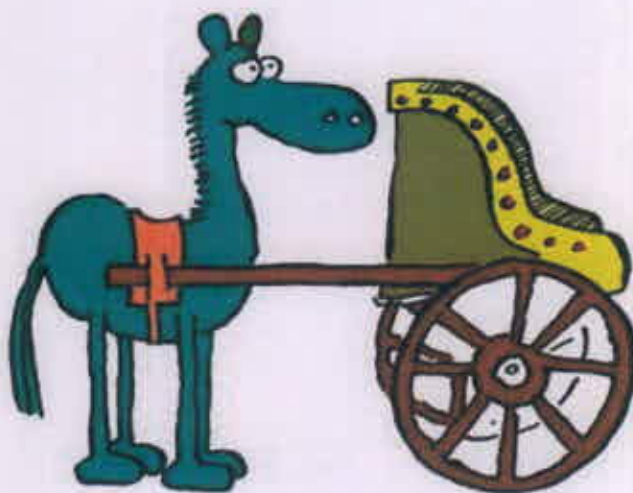

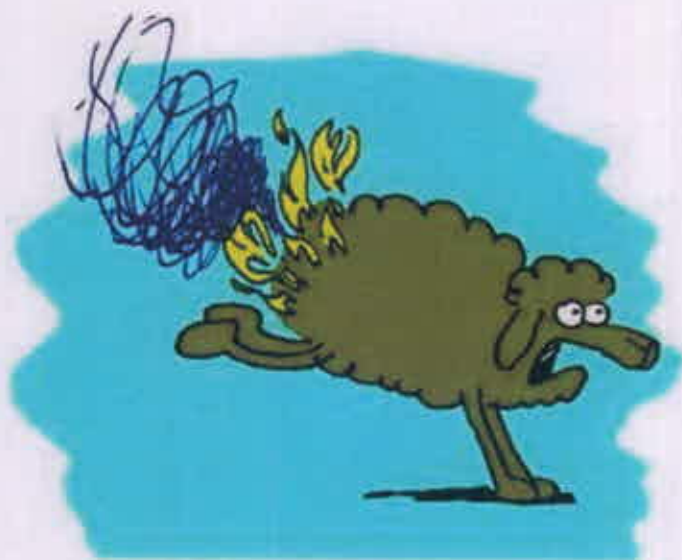

## wet blanket

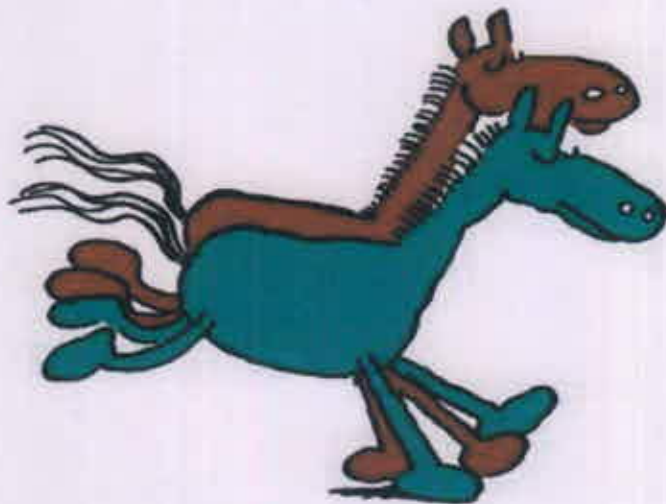

## get the hang of something

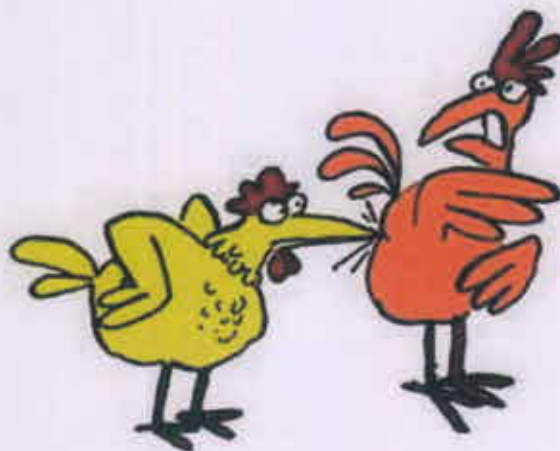

## buy a pig in a poke

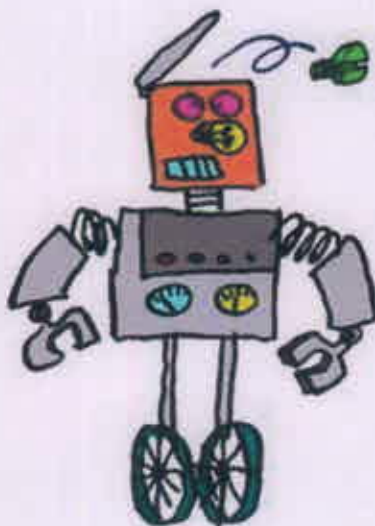

### go great guns

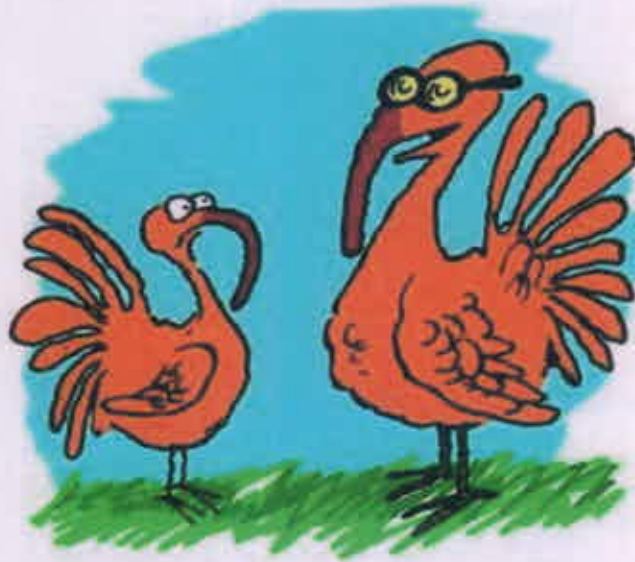
